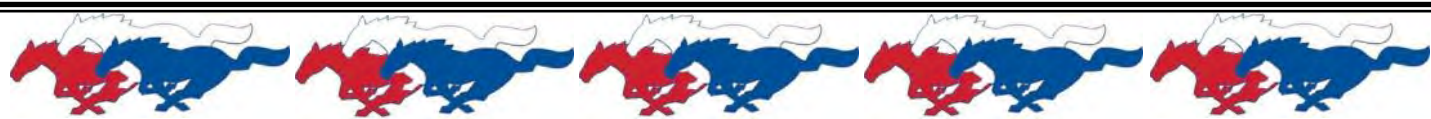

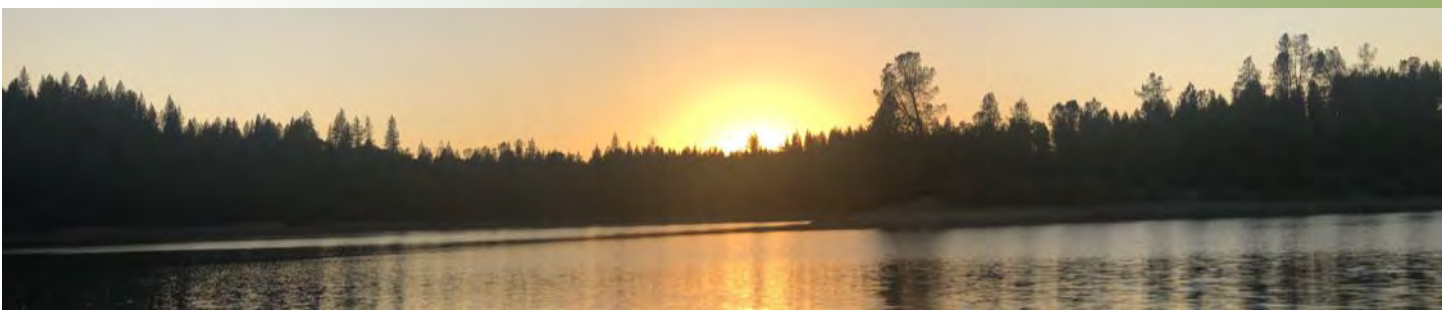
**Editors Note: the next paragraph was told by the McCabes since this all happened while Brian was sharing his Corona with the fish.**
