



He also reached out to other clubs to make sure this year's donations were as good if not better than last year. We are Proud to say it was! Our calculations tell us it was a 33% increase over 2020!

Approximately 70 cars brought food and donations, and enjoyed a drive through the beautiful countryside in perfect weather! We raised 6,034 meals, Food contributions totaled 1,462 pounds and monetary contributions totaled \$2,408. (See the thank you letter from the Food Bank to see just how successful it was!) This was a very fun event, Thanks to the Cobra Experience in Martinez who opened the parking lot for the food drop-off and thankfully opened the restrooms for us! After all the food was collected we enjoyed seeing all the beautiful cars and waited for the 3 special Mustangs to lead us through the back roads and beautiful countryside of Conta Costa County. Ford Powered Drive for Hunger

Thank you so much for your April 10, 2021 food donations to the Food Bank of Contra Costa and Solano. The total of 1,462 pounds of food and \$2,408 you brought in equates to 6,034 meals for our neighbors struggling to make ands meet.

How does your hard work make a difference? Since the Covid pandemic began in March, 2020 the Food Bank has been supporting 280,000 people each month. That is 100,000 more people seeking help than just a few monits ago. In Fiscal Year 2019 you helped us distribute about 25,000,000 pounds of food. The last year we were up to 31,000,000 pounds and we are on track to hit 40,000,000 pounds this current year.

While the need is great – the community has risen to the challenge. Thanks to generous and energetic floks like you who arganize food drives, no one has been turned away. This would not happen if everyone waited for "somecene elie" to make it happen it was up to YOU, and YOU did it!

We know there is a bright future ahead, with the virus under control and the economy booming back, but it will take all of us working together to bring it about.


