The next car show meeting is Wednesday May 4th at 6:00PM in the parking lot across the street from the Veterans Hall in Suisun City. This will be our last meeting before the car show so I'm hoping for a big turnout. We will be making up the registration packets on Saturday May 14th from 9:00 AM until Noon at East Bay Classics, if you have signed up for that we'll see you there. Set up day is Thursday the 19th, Club members who volunteered to work the show can pick up their special Event Staff T-shirts then.

Currently we have 205 cars registered for the 219 spaces, we have 6 judged spaces and 8 display spaces open. We have 172 of the 200 Saturday




